Examination Sites—All examinations are given at Pearson Vue testing centers. See <http://www.pearsonvue.com/abnm> for more information.

Late Fee—A late fee of \$500 will be assessed for applications, supporting documents, or fees received after the deadlines, although there is no guarantee that the ABNM will accept your application.

Application Withdrawal Fee—The registration fee of \$2400 will be refunded if applications are withdrawn prior to July 15th. The \$500 processing fee is non-refundable.

Refunds—No refund will be given for not taking the examination, except for circumstances beyond the control of an applicant. The applicant must notify the ABNM by the scheduled date of examination and provide an explanation why it is not possible to take the examination. If the explanation is acceptable to the ABNM, the registration fee of \$2400 minus any fees charged by Pearson Vue may be refunded. No refund will be given if the applicant fails to take the examination on the scheduled date without first notifying the ABNM.

Applicants requiring such accommodation must contact the Board no later than July 1 of the year the applicant wishes to take the examination and request copies of the necessary procedures and form.
